


Figure 9: Bruce Vorland's Homepage




Figure 10: Paul Rumme's Homepage




Figure 11: Bob Goski's Homepage




Figure 12: Robert Clayton's Homepage




Figure 13: Course Login Links for Moodle

To make it easy for students to access the freshman Conversation Moodle curriculum there are links to each teacher's course. These links are direct links to each teacher's course. This helps students bypass the main Moodle entry. Students will first get the default log in page for the Moodle site, then be forwarded directly to their teacher's course where they then type in the "course enrollment key."




Figure 22: English Words for AIT Freshmen




Figure 23: English 1 Syllabus




Figure 24: First Handout
